Foundation Subjects

Our geography question is why is our world wonderful? The children will identify and locate characteristics of the UK on a map and identify and locate human and physical features. Children will learn about uses of everyday materials within our science lessons. For DT, the children will explore a balanced diet. They will describe different foods and then construct their own wraps that meets the design brief. Our music theme will be based on instruments through musical story telling.

Fruit and Water

In Year 2, children will continue to have fruit provided for them at break times. We would encourage pupils to bring in a named bottle of water.

Literacy and Maths

Throughout Year 2 the children will continued to be grouped for literacy and maths so that we can accommodate to each of their needs.

PE Kits
